



Champion Sportsplex Sports Camp

-General Information-

Included as a part of the Champion Sportsplex Sports Camp is supervision, instruction, and play of the sports offered. Other activities will be offered during the day to give the children a diverse experience. Champion Sportsplex will supply enough staff to accommodate all of the needs of the children, and children will be supervised at all times. Champion Sportsplex is fully insured. Please be aware that this is not a day care center, but a Sports Camp. All of the children signed up to participate in the camp will be required to participate in the sports that are being offered.

Sports Camp Schedule

- The Sports Camp is scheduled to run for eight weeks beginning Monday, June 20th and ending Friday, August 19th.
- The hours of the Sports Camp are from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. If you feel that other arrangements concerning drop off and/or pick up times are necessary for your child, please speak with the Sports Camp Staff so we may discuss the options that are available to you.
- A lunch break will be provided for all children enrolled within the Sports Camp. The lunch period is scheduled from 11:00a.m. to 12:00p.m.
- Sports and various activities are scheduled at different times throughout the day, and usually last between one to two hours long. A tentative schedule is made at the beginning of each week. Please be aware that the scheduled activities for each week are subject to change, as the number of children enrolled throughout the Sports Camp will vary.

Payment

Payments are due Monday at the start of each week (cash or check). Payment plans are available for camp enrollment of three weeks or more.

When you register your child, please remember that you are reserving a place for your child within the camp. The number of staff, as well as the sports activities that are played, is based on the number of children on the camp roster. Credits based on absences, and full and/or partial refunds will not be granted.

Health

Unfortunately, we cannot admit any child who is sick. Children who become ill at the camp must be picked up immediately. A child may not attend the camp if he has the following symptoms:

- Fever in excess of 101
- Uncontrolled Diarrhea
- Vomiting
- Persistent soar throat, coughs, aches, chills, or any flu-like symptoms
- Contagious disease or infection (conjunctivitis, strep, chicken pox, undiagnosed rash, etc)

Medication

Medications will be administered but all need to be signed in, on a log, daily, by the parent/guardian. Staff members, dispensing, medications, will sign and date the log to ensure that medication is dispensed properly. We will not administer expired medications. Every medication needs to be marked with the child's first and last name, must be in original container, and clearly indicate contents and instructions. Siblings cannot share medications. Over the counter medications will not be given for more than three consecutive days unless a doctor's written permission is provided.

Rules and Regulations

Please be advised that the following rules and regulations are in affect at all times in Champion Sportsplex. It is our desire to maintain superior sportsmanship at all times. Campers MUST listen to the instructors at all times. When a child misbehaves, he/she will not be allowed to participate in specific activities because of their conduct. Parents will be contacted if their child continually misbehaves and/or does not listen to instruction. While in the gym, the following activities ARE NOT tolerated. If a child within the Sports Camp is caught performing said actions, immediate removal of the premises will occur.

- NO SPITTING
- NO HANGING ON RIMS AND NETS
- NO GUM WHILE IN GYM

- NO FOUL LANGUAGE (we must remember that minors are present)
- NO HORSE PLAY
- NO BEVERAGE OTHER THAN WATER IS ALLOWED IN GYM AREA
- NO FOOD IN GYM (other than designated for a specific event)
- NO STANDING ON THE BLEECHERS
- NO LITTERING IN THE GYM, LOCKER ROOM OR SURROUNDING PROPERTY
- NO FIGHTING WITHIN THE AREA OF THE COMPLEX
- COMPLIANCE AT ALL TIMES TO THE TIME LIMITS IN THE FACILITY AS MEMBERSHIP GROWS
- LOCKER ROOMS AND BATHROOM FACILITIES SHALL BE KEPT CLEAN AT ALL TIMES, IN THE EVENT OF AN ACCIDENT, A STAFF MEMBER SHOULD BE NOTIFIED IMMEDIATELY

Camp Termination

Champion Sportsplex reserves the right to discontinue services to any family that does not fulfill the camp requirements. These requirements include, but are not limited to, incomplete documents (i.e. Emergency Contact forms), delinquent payments, and disciplinary issues that are not corrected within a reasonable period of time.

Additional Information/Reminders

Throughout the day, the Sports Camp will break for drinks, snack, and lunch. Please make sure that your child is supplied with enough beverage and/or food to last *the entire time* that they are here. Though Champion Sportsplex is not able to supply meals, beverages are available for purchase.

In case of necessity, it is important that you bring an additional change of clothes for your child. Participation in some activities may leave your child's clothing wet or grimy – the additional change of clothes will help them to remain comfortable throughout the rest of the day.

Additional clothing or belongings may be kept in a locker. Lockers are accessible for camper's to use; however, it is the parent's obligation to supply a lock. If you choose to bring a lock with a key, a spare key must be given to the office staff. In the event a lock with a combination is used, the combination must be supplied to the office staff as well.
